Dear Peabody Families,

In an effort to support our Peabody students, teachers, and staff, the PTA is asking for donations to the annual Peabody Activity Fund.

Donations to the Activity Fund allow for the purchase of basic classroom consumables such as markers, crayons, paints, and general supplies that support and enrich the various grade-level studies throughout the year. Additionally, the Activity Fee purchases books for every classroom; provides necessities for school-wide special instruction in art, library, music, library, physical education, and special education; contributes to the care of the Peabody Garden; and provides supply needs such as camera film, ink, and printing paper for teachers throughout the year. Lastly, the Activity Fund pays field trip transportation fees and entrance fees.

One of the main goals of the Activity Fee is to minimize requests for additional contributions or donations throughout the year from teachers and room parents.
