WHO: Parents, teachers, support staff, and community members

**HOW:** Elected by peers (parents elect parents, etc.)

**WHAT:** Advise the principal on a variety of school matters including budget, priorities, culture, and family engagement

## LSATs and PTOs

## **Local School Advisory Team**

- Required at each school
- Parents, teachers and school community members
- No budget
- Helps to set school priorities and direction
- LSAT goals should align with and support school goals

## **Parent Organization (PTO)**

- Not required, but recommended
- Parent-led membership largely made up of parents
- 501 (c) 3
- Helps carry out school priorities (fundraising, volunteers, etc.)
- Parent organization goals should align with and support school goals
